

Disasters in Viet Nam


Typhoon, flood, flash flood, draught, landslide, forest fire,...



Human losses by type of natural disaster (2001 - 2010)




Human losses





STRUCTURE FOR NATURAL DISASTER RISK MANAGEMENT



Responses to natural disaster

- Consolidate the system of laws (DL), policies and mechanisms;
- Consolidate organizational structure;
- Human resources development and socialization;
- Community awareness raising (CBDRM);
- Develop sciences and technologies related to natural disaster prevention, response and mitigation;
- Ensure safety for dyke, reservoir and dam systems;
- Enhance the search and rescue capacities;
- Promote international cooperation and integration, ect.

DISASTER RECOVERY

Resources: National reserve, annual reserved funds from the state budget; local funds for disaster prevention, and voluntary contributions from organisations and individuals.

Short-term support: Emergency period;

Medium-term support;

Long-term support.



DISASTER RECOVERY ACTIVITIES

Disaster recovery activities include:

- ✓ Relief aid of food, medicine and other basic necessities to stabilise people's lives;
- ✓ Statistical evaluation of damage caused by natural disasters, support needs and remedial proposals;
- ✓ Provide plant varieties and animal breeds supplies, fuel and other essentials to restore production;
- ✓ Provide essential commodities and implementation of management measures to stabilise markets;
- ✓ Implementation of environmental sanitation, disease prevention in areas affected by disasters;
- ✓ Repair, restoration and upgrading of infrastructures

CHALLENGES

- ✓ Production system is less sustainable
- ✓ Infrastructure is vulnerable and not strong enough
- ✓ Resources: Human and finance
- ✓ Tool for damage and need assessment
- ✓ Coordination
- ✓ Information sharing
