


The climate of the Philippines is tropical and maritime. It is characterized by relatively high temperature, high humidity and abundant rainfall. The country typically experiences average temperatures of around 26.6°C which can drop down to 25.5°C during the cool months of December and January and go up to 28.3°C during the warm months of April and May.
